Registration Application

Folow these five easy steps to apply for registration:

1. Take pictures - If the donkey is over 12 months of age the registry needs a photo of the left side and the right side. These photo can be regular prints, Polaroid or digital. These photo are placed on the back of the registration for identification purposes. These do not have to be the best of pictures, but it is important that they show a full view of each side.
2. Complete and sign the self inspection form and determine which category you wish to register your miniature donkey.
3. Fill out this application form and all of the pedigree information on the reverse side if available. Pedigrees are not required for registration, but if they are known they should be indicated. When unknown put untraced.
4. Complete the owner and breeder information on this form exactly as you want it to show on all registration certificates.
5. Enclose all of the above along with the appropriate fees, or credit card info and send it to the address listed above.

Type of membership:

Memberships: You do not have to become a member in order to register, but you get a discount on registrations, and ratings are available to you. Membership fees are primarily used for promotional purposes. With the proper funding from membership fees, many things can be done to promote donkeys and the donkey industry in general. Even though you as an individual, may be spending advertising money now, just think how much more we can accomplish as a group of contributors ! Your dollars invested in membership fees will come back to you in the future value of your miniature donkeys, and your membership fees will bring you new customers and bring the miniature donkey the recognition it deserves.

Lifetime: \$180 - This is a one time fee and entitles you to a 10% discount on all registrations and services provided by IMDR. Names of Lifetime Members are published in each issue of MDT in the IMDR page.

Five Year Renewable: \$70 - Pay for four years and get one year free! Renewable after five years.

One Year Renewable: \$18 - This membership is good for one year, from Jan 1st of the year applied to Jan 1st of the next year and is renewable on or before January 1st of each year thereafter.

Note: You may upgrade your membership at any time to a Lifetime Membership.

Type of Registration:

- Regular Registration \$18 members - \$22 non members.** This is the fee for donkeys who are over 2 years of age, and do not have existing registration papers for transfer.
- Temporary Registration \$12.50 - \$15 non members** for donkeys under 2 years of age (For foals under 4 months of age **members** may deduct \$2.50 for each parent registered with IMDR, or for parents who have applications being applied for with this application. Foals under 10 months of age do not require photos)
- Temporary IMDR to Permanent - \$8 members - \$10 non members.** To be applied for when a donkey that has been registered temporary and has reached 2 years of age.
- Pet Quality or Gelding Registration \$8 - \$10 non members.** Non breeding stock because of extreme faults, or a gelded jack
- Transfer \$10 - members or non members** - Transfer ownership on IMDR registration, or to transfer registration from any other registry (you must submit a copy of both sides of other registration paper, and follow the same five steps listed on the front page.
- Rating/Conformation Review** - Available only to members - \$35

Faults for classification as Pet Quality: The areas of conformation which would make a miniature donkey eligible for either Regular or Pet Quality (non breeding stock) are as follows:

Genital defects: Adult Jacks only - Cryptorchid (having only one testicle extended and over two years of age) If this condition exists this jack should not be used for breeding and should be registered as non-breeding **Pet Quality** stock.

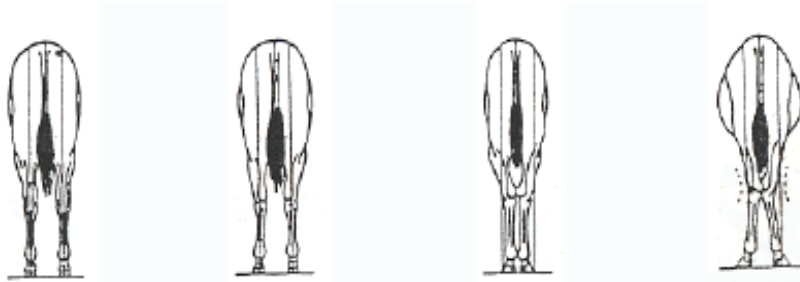
Mouth Defects: If an overbite (top teeth extend out over the bottom teeth) or underbite (bottom teeth extend out beyond the top teeth) exists that extends in excess of 1/4" the donkey should be registered as **Pet Quality**.

Teeth Meet evenly **Parrot Mouth**
Over bite 1/4" or less **Monkey Mouth**
Under bite 1/4" or less **Parrot or Monkey Mouth**
In excess of 1/4"

Rear Leg Faults: Cow-hocked (Rear legs bent in so far that they rub at the hocks). If your donkey falls into the last category it should be registered as **Pet Quality**.



Ideal **Slight turn out** **Close**
But not touching **Cow hocked**

Note: If you have checked any of the boxes to the far right the donkey must be registered as Pet Quality. Of course any donkey that is obviously deformed from anything other than an accident, should also be registered as **Pet Quality**. When in question, please ask the registry.
